

Chapter President Leadership Scholarship

The Wisconsin FCCLA Foundation Board of Directors wishes to recognize a Wisconsin FCCLA Chapter President for their leadership in their chapter, school, and community with a **\$500 scholarship**. The foundation would like to encourage and support an individual as they pursue their future career plans.

Funding for this scholarship is generated from donations that support the sponsored programs of the Wisconsin FCCLA Foundation including chapters, individuals, businesses, and universities.

The scholarship applicant must:

- be a graduating senior
- served as a current or former middle school, junior high, or high school chapter president
- be a current FCCLA chapter member
- have a 3.0 grade point average or above
- plan to further their education at a technical college or at a four-year college or university

Scholarship applicants will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- 1. Completion of the application form.
- 2. Required recommendations from:
 - the applicant's current chapter adviser
 - guidance counselor, principal or district administrator
 - a current employer, community leader, clergy or school staff member.

The recommendations should be completed on school letterhead stationery and address the following:

- Name of the applicant, chapter name, school and date.
- Describe the relationship to the scholarship applicant; including the length of time you have known the applicant.
- Share how has the applicant's leadership traits contributed to chapter, school, and/or community activities.
- Describe the impact of this scholarship on the student's future goals.
- Include the writer's title, address, and date.

RULES/GUIDELINES FOR COMPLETING THIS GRANT APPLICATION:

- 1. Complete The Wisconsin FCCLA Foundation Chapter President Leadership Scholarship Application, answer two essay questions, and provide three letters of recommendation.
- 2. A scholarship certificate of \$500 will granted to the selected applicant. A committee consisting of foundation members, former advisers, and university staff persons will determine the recipient. The scholarship will be presented at the Wisconsin State Leadership Conference.
- 3. The scholarship application, essays, and letters of recommendations must be postmarked or emailed by March 1 to:

4. To receive the \$500 scholarship, send a follow-up letter at the end of the first semester of post secondary school to Carol Subera. Include a copy of your transcript which is required for the funds to be awarded.
